## **Golden time Science Club**

This half term in Golden Time Science Club, we have had been carrying out some activities from the British Science Association pack with the theme 'Journeys' in celebration of the 25th anniversary of the Eurotunnel. Each week, children from Key Stage 2 have been exploring significant concepts in science with Dr Dyer. We have

looked at global issues such as pollution of the ocean by plastics, and how air pollution by diesel cars is monitored. We have also considered how important it is to look after our mental health so examined how the brain works. We constructed a model of the brain with play dough, and also with pipe cleaners to illustrate the connection of neurones when memories are made (shown in photo). Last week we looked at electricity so made a large circuit by joining hands as a class, and then mini circuits using play dough to light up an LED. Hopefully the children are suitably enthused for Science
