This week's learning...

- Reading Winnie the Witch.
- Reading and writing words to describe Winnie.
- Learning about capacity - full, half full, empty.
- Measuring different amounts of "potions".
- Investigating the numbers 4 and 5.
- Practising our blending skills during phonics.

At home your child could...

- Describe what Winnie the Witch looks like.
- Write words of things they would like to put into a witch's spell - frog, mat, sand, bush etc.
- Fill 3 different containers with different amounts of "potions" and say how much is in each one - full, half full, nearly empty, empty, nearly full.
- Use their phonics to sound out and read familiar words in their favourite books.
- Go on a number 4 and 5 hunt. Can they find groups of 4 or 5 objects - leaves, buttons, forks, apples etc.

Next week we will be...

- Reading Princess and the Wizard.
- Writing a party invitation.
- Discussing features of wizards and making wizards using different tools and materials.
- Joining in with the school writing week and labelling a picture.
- Finding one more and one less.
