We have introduced our new book - 'We're going on a Bear Hunt' by Michael Rosen.


We are going to be hunting and looking for bears.

Can you build a cave at home to hid in?


Rabbit & Squirrel Room News

Coronavirus Guidance

Early Years Pupil Premium & 2 Year Old Funding

Children aged 3 & 4 who are accessing 15 hours universal childcare in Cambridgeshire and meet certain criteria, may be eligible for the Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP). This is extra funding paid to early years providers to improve outcomes for these children.

A child will be eligible for pupil premium funding if they are in receipt of the 15 hours of government funded early education and meet certain criteria.

The additional funding can then be used for additional sessions, resources or targeted support for individual children.

2 year old children may also be entitled to funding for 15 hours per week from the term after their second birthday if they also meet certain criteria.

Head Lice

Phonics The children in the Rabbit Group are now taking part in a short Read Write Inc. phonics session each morning. We have started by learning the Read Write Inc. scheme pictures which will prepare us for learning the written letters and their corresponding sounds next term. In a few weeks time will be learning how to talk in 'Fred Talk' by blending and segmenting the sounds in simple words.

Those children in the Rabbit Group who are not currently attending due to the current Covid situation should receive a video from Mrs Beresford today via Evidence Me so that they can also learn the pictures we have been learning at preschool.
