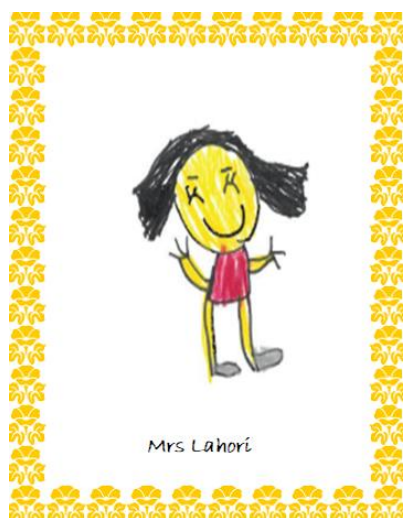
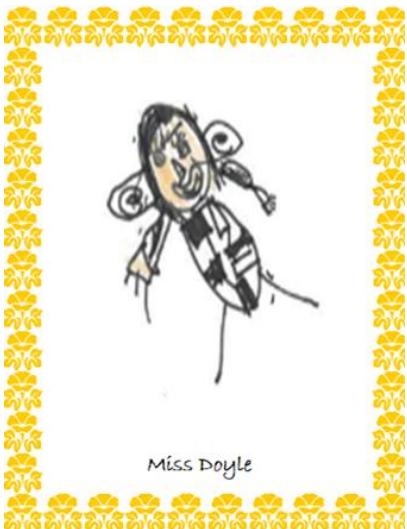
Curriculum Leads for Play

Mrs Major and Mrs Ray



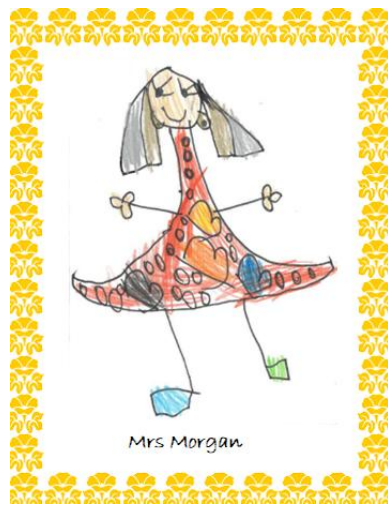

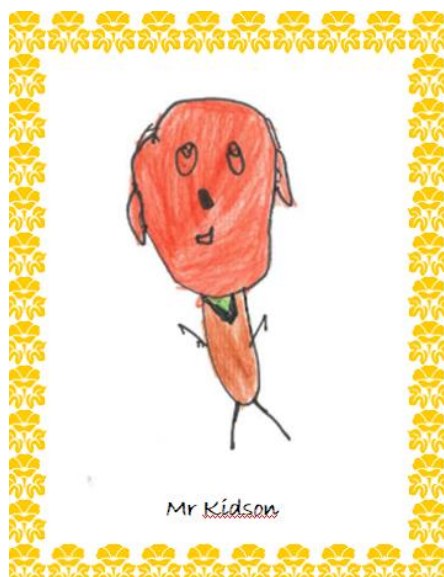
Our Senior Leaders and Team Leaders
