The children have loved getting ready for Christmas in the 3 and 4 year old room. We have decorated our tree (many times!!) and made Christmas cards and decorations.

We have listened to the Nativity story and enjoyed playing with our knitted Nativity set. We have also learnt some Christmas songs ready to sing to you all at our Stay and Play sessions next week.



This week we have also introduced each child to their writing name card, which helps them to learn the correct letter formation for the letters in their name. The name card shows the starting dot for each letter and an arrow to show the writing direction. The name cards are available for the children to get from the mark making trolley each time they make a picture, to copy and help them practise the correct letter formations.

After Christmas we will be sending home a copy of your child's name card for you to practise at home as well. For some children just learning to write the first letter will be enough at this stage.
