Term Dates: The pre-school closes for Christmas at 3.00 pm on Wednesday 19th December 2018. We re-open on Monday 7th January 2019 for the Spring Term which runs until Friday 5th April 2019.

Our Holiday Club will be open on Thursday 20th, Friday 21st December 2018, and Wednesday 2nd January 2019 from 8.00 am until 6.00 pm each day.

Please note that the Care and Learning Centre will be closed for all sessions on Thursday 3rd and Friday 4th January 2019 for training days in line with Monkfield Park Primary School.

Starting School:

If your child is due to start school in September 2019 you need to register by 15th January 2019. Please go to the following website to register: <u>admissions@cambridgeshire.gov.uk</u>

<u>Collecting Children:</u> Please ensure you collect your child on time at the end of their sessions; if for any reason you are going to be late please ring and let us know. Please let us know if someone different will be collecting your child., as we will not let a child go with someone we are not expecting. If someone unexpected comes to collect your child we will ring you using the contact numbers provided to authorise the pick up. Please note that we do not allow anyone under sixteen years of age to collect children from the Care and Learning Centre pre-school.
