Maths

In the first half term of the year, we will focus on re-introducing the children to Power Maths. Our first topic will be learning about place value up to 1,000,000. We will then move on to addition and subtraction. Other aspects of the curriculum will be covered during lesson starters so we can start to fill gaps in children's learning.



In DT we will work over the term making our own Mars Rover using moving parts and CAM mechanisms.

History

The history of space travel will be the focus of our history learning this half term.

English

During this term we will be building on children's understanding of the features of different types of non-fiction texts, including writing a biography about an astronaut.

We will be reading the novel 'Cosmic' – it's one giant leap for boy-kind. The children will make predictions, infer character thoughts and feelings, and write their own chapters.

PSHE

Friends and Family. The children will consider their networks of people who are special to them, and how they are changing and developing as they get older. They will continue to develop their skills in making new friendships, and in maintaining and coping with challenges in existing friendships and other relationships.
