Computing

Using LOGO, children will explore commands and language for programming. Developing into composing algorithms for drawing shapes developed into code.

English

We will be writing diaries and letters as evacuees, newspaper reports, as well as writing stories set in a historical context. We will use the text “The Lion and the Unicorn” and “The diary of Edie Benson.”

Maths

We will be working on statistics, angles, 2D shapes, position and direction.

Science

We will be looking at the digestive system – the parts and its function. Also, we will be identifying different types of teeth and their function.

Music

We will be using the Charanga programme to learn how to sing The Beatles song ‘Blackbird’, and learning some WW2 songs.

History

We will be finding out about WW2 and what it was like to be a child at that time. We will be visiting Stibbington, to find out more about the life of an evacuee.
