



# Year 4

## Computing

Using LOGO, children will explore commands and language for programming. Developing into composing algorithms for drawing shapes developed into code.

## Maths

We will be working on statistics, angles, 2D shapes, position and direction.

## Music

We will be using the Charanga programme to learn how to sing The Beatles song 'Blackbird', and learning some WW2 songs.

## R.E.

We will discuss how and why people across the world pray, listen to stories, and discuss ideas.

## PSHE

We will be learning about the range of changes that they will experience in their lives.

## History

We will be finding out about WW2 and what it was like to be a child at that time. We will be visiting Stibbington, to find out more about the life of an evacuee.

## P.E.

We will be fine tuning our gymnastic and athletic skills.

## English

We will be writing diaries and letters as evacuees, newspaper reports, as well as writing stories set in a historical context. We will use the text "The Lion and the Unicorn" and "The diary of Edie Benson."

## Science

We will be looking at the digestive system – the parts and its function. Also, we will be identifying different types of teeth and their function.

## DT

The children will imagine they are an evacuee and make a teddy bear to pack in their suitcase.
