Creation	Something being made that was not there before.
Unique	One of a kind. Made different to others. Not the same.
Valued	Worthy of love and belonging. Precious. Important.
Neighbour	Someone who you may meet in your day-to-day life. Another person. Someone who lives in the same area as you.
Waiter	Someone who serves another. Someone trained and skilled in looking out for what another person needs.
Genesis	Origin, source. Where something comes from.

Why do we care?

What does it 'look' like when we care for others?

What do people of faith, and of no faith, believe about looking after our world?

Many faiths have a description of how the Earth, the universe and everything in it, were created.

Christians, Muslims, and Jews share the creation story, told at the very beginning of their holy texts in a book called Genesis, which means 'origin' or 'source' – where things first began.
