


#### **The Christmas Countdown Begins.**

#### **Gate Security**

Although we are fully in the festive spirit in school, we still have to be aware of the day to day issues of keeping the children safe. Recently, we have discovered that the voice entry pedestrian internal gate has been left open on a number of occasions. The gate ensures that anyone wishing to access the school site during the school day must speak with the school office to establish that they have a bona fide reason for doing so.

When visiting school, once the office staff have opened the gate for you, please make sure that the gate is securely closed behind you. In addition, when leaving the site it is vitally important that for the safety of the children and staff you check that the gate is securely shut behind you. Please make sure that you listen for the gate to click which indicates that it is fully closed.

We have put up some new signs to remind everyone of the need to close the gates to keep all the children safe and we would be grateful if you could remind others of the importance of closing the gate and checking that it has locked. Many thanks for your help in this matter.
