Drone competition

As part of Amazon's new delivery service 'Prime Air', it has invited Cambridgeshire schools to enter a 'Design a Drone' competition. The competition invites children to either build a drone using everyday materials such as wood, met-

Designing the drone will be set as a homework challenge next Monday for those classes that are involved. On Wednesday, to help with the children's understanding of what a drone actually is, we were lucky enough to have a
