Attainment measures show how pupils have performed in tests and assessments but do not take pupils' starting points into account.

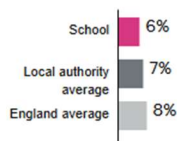
Pupils meeting expected standard in reading, writing and maths ?

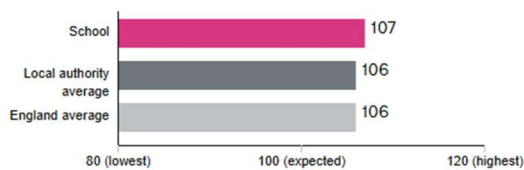
Pupils achieving at a higher standard in reading, writing and maths ?

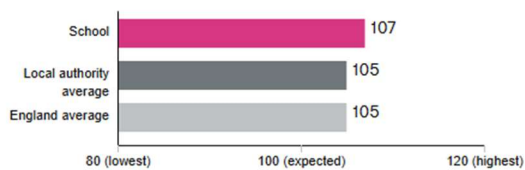
Average score in reading ?
